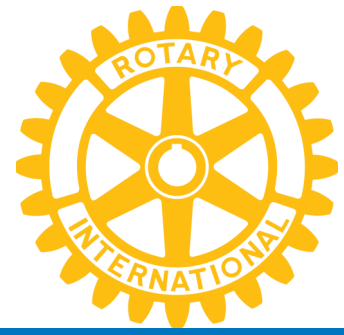

Selection of 2020-21 District Governor

For those districts that have completed the process of selecting your DG 2020-21 or are close to it, congratulations! For everyone else, please begin. DG Payee Form

If you will have personal expenses such as mileage to the airport or parking at the airport associated with the International Assembly, please complete the [District Governor Payee Form](#) and email to vendors@rotary.org as soon as possible. This form must be completed in order for Rotary International to reimburse you for any eligible International Assembly expenses. If this reimbursement should go to your personal account, complete section C. If this reimbursement should go to your district's account, complete sections D and E.

If your district is participating in the DG funding test, Rotary International already has your district's bank account data on file. Nothing else is needed to ensure you receive your DG funding payment in July 2018.

If your district is not participating in the DG funding test, your July 2018 DG funding payment will go to the same account as you've indicated above for the International Assembly reimbursement.

Reminders

Election & Reporting of Club Officers

Reminding your clubs about the election of the 2018-19 officers will get them headed in the right direction for the next Rotary year. 31 December 2018 is the deadline for election of officers and 1 February 2019 is the deadline for reporting the officers to Rotary International. Current club officers can submit this information via the Club Administration section of [My Rotary](#), approved vendors (DACdb, ClubRunner, etc.), or by sending the information to data@rotary.org.

U.S. Clubs & Districts: IRS Deadline

The IRS requires that all clubs/districts in the U.S. and its territories file an annual information return. If your club/district's tax year follows the Rotary year, the deadline to file is 15 November. More information is available on irs.gov and in our [FAQ](#).
